The faculty feedback of IMI-Kolkata was taken over a period of one month.


The total number of respondents was 25. Data were collected on 5-point Likert Scale, where "5" indicates "Excellent" and "1" indicates "Poor".










Satisfaction with Career Growth Opportunities provided by the Institute




Opportunities for Faculty Development Programme given by the Institute







Industry Collaboration opportunities given by the Institute



Opportunities for teaching in the Executive Program by the Institute







Satisfaction with Teaching-Learning Infrastructure




Satisfaction with the availability of Research Resources



Satisfaction with Academic Process Management






Perception of Work-Life Balance
