





Arshiya Singh, Director Global Compensation at BCG, highlighted that 80% of Gen Z prioritizes purpose over paychecks and stressed cross-generational collaboration to leverage both technical expertise and experience. Kuldeep VM, CHRO at WHSmith India, urged organizations to align with Gen Z's dynamic needs through practical applications of knowledge.

Employer branding was also explored, with Debashish Ghosh (Berkadia) emphasizing differentiation, Varghese Chakkummootil (FNF India) highlighting employee experiences, and Divya Sonali Minz (Avnet) addressing Gen Z's focus on technology and career clarity.
